SUBJECT: Waiver for USAF Flight Surgeon Primary Aircraft Sortie Requirements

USAF flight surgeons are experiencing difficulties meeting their flying hour requirements along with the requirement to log at least 50 percent of their minimum sortie requirements in the primary assigned aircraft.

In accordance with (IAW) AFI 11-202, Volume 1, paragraph 3.11 with the waiver authority delegated to AFMSA/SG3P for flight surgeons, I am granting a waiver to the requirement for paragraph 3.11 (to include Table 1) of logging at least 50 percent of the annual and semi-annual sortie requirements in primary unit aircraft for all USAF flight surgeons.

Flight Surgeons are still required to fly the minimum flight time requirement of 4.0 hours per month IAW the DoDFMR (DoD Financial Management Regulation) to be entitled to aircrew incentive pay.

Any flight duties and flying time logged aboard non-AF aircraft must be performed IAW AFI 11-202, Volume 1, paragraph 3.10 and AFI 11-401 paragraph 1.11 and AFI 11-402.

All USAF flight surgeons will maintain a copy of this memorandum for future reference. A copy of this memorandum will be filed in the flight record folder for all flight surgeons affected by this waiver. This memorandum has been coordinated with AF/A3O-AIF, AF Office of Primary Responsibility for AFI 11-202, AFI 11-401 and AFI 11-402.
