DAILY 600 FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Go Pill Form 5 – *Daily 600* is completed in two parts.

Complete Part I upon prescription of a go-pill. Informed consent must be verified, then medication, dosage, frequency and total number prescribed recorded. **Do not enter any classified information on the Daily 600 as this document is part of the medical record. Operational names, dates, and number of sorties flown may be classified.**

**The normal Modafinil dose for operational use is: 200 mg po q 8 hrs prn
Modafinil use should not normally exceed 24 consecutive hours.**

**The normal Dexedrine dose for operational use is: 10 mg po q 4 hrs prn
Dexedrine use should not exceed a dosage of 20 mg in any 24-hour period.**

Complete Part II following medication use, or return of the medication. Any medication not consumed or returned must be accounted for with a full description of the circumstances.

Medication use over a series of days requires additional form 5s. Complete a form 5 for each day of use on part II of the form.

The *Daily 600* must be completed each day for every squadron aircrew member taking go-pills. File the *Daily 600* in the individual's medical document. Do not forward to MAJCOM SG unless requested.

Any adverse reaction or unusual occurrence possibly related to go-pill usage will be noted on this form. If such an occurrence is noted, complete a "*Go Pill*" Form 6 – *Unusual Occurrence Report* and forwarded to MAJCOM SG.

All individuals prescribed a go-pill must have a form 8, *Operation Summary* completed and retained in their medical record, using information contained in form 5s and based on a final interview with their flight surgeon.
